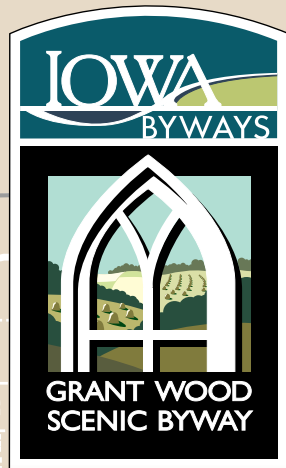
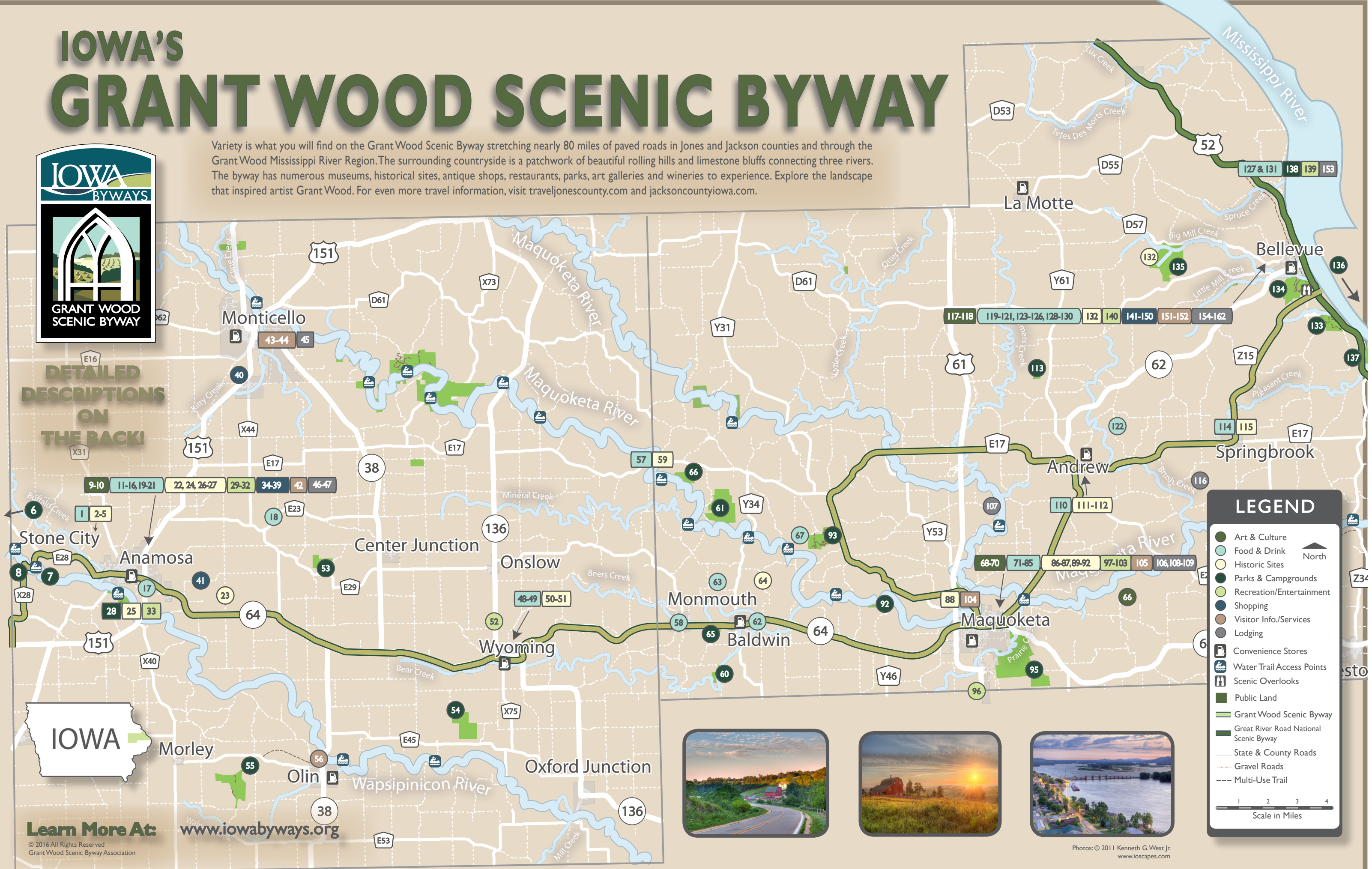


IOWA'S GRANT WOOD SCENIC BYWAY
